CHAPTER 35 ANIMAL CARE

5-3507. EXHIBITION OF DOGFIGHTS. (1) Every person who knowingly owns, sees, keeps, trains, buys or sells dogs for the purpose of a public or e display of combat between two (2) or more dogs in which the fighting, g, maiming or injuring of dogs is a significant feature is guilty of a

2) Every person who knowingly advertises, promotes, organizes, pipates or knowingly has a monetary interest in a public or private by of combat between two (2) or more dogs in which the fighting, ng, maiming or injuring of dogs is a significant feature is guilty of a

3) Every person who is knowingly present as a spectator at any place preparations are being made for an exhibition of the fighting of dogs the intent to be present at such preparations or to be knowingly present ich exhibition shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon tion, be punished in accordance with section 25-3520A, Idaho Code.

4) Nothing in this section prohibits: demonstrations of the hunting, ng, working or tracking skills of dogs or the lawful use of dogs for ng, herding, working, tracking or self and property protection; the use gs in the management of livestock or the training, raising, breeding or ng of dogs for any purpose not prohibited by law. An exhibition of phting shall not be construed to mean the type of confrontation that s unintentionally because of a chance encounter between two (2) or more rolled dogs.
