CHAPTER 28 DOGS

5-2804. TAKING UP DOGS WITHOUT COLLAR AND TAG. After sixty (60) days the date of the board's meeting at which this measure is adopted, it be the duty of the sheriff of the county to seize and impound any and gs, other than those located in a municipality within said county which nacted and is enforcing a dog license law, at large without a collar such license tag or disc as prescribed in section <u>25-2803</u>, Idaho Code. g which is impounded pursuant to this section shall be killed before (5) days, excluding weekends and holidays, have elapsed from the time of aking up of the dog. After the five (5) days, excluding weekends and lys, have elapsed and a reasonable effort has failed to locate the the sheriff or his delegate may kill the dog in a humane manner. It be the duty of the sheriff of the county or his delegate also to seize apound any and all such dogs at large wearing collars with such license or discs, on which the owner has failed to obtain or renew the annual se; provided, that when a dog wearing a collar with a license attached een taken up, the sheriff shall notify the owner, if known, who may upon recover possession of the dog on payment of the license fee, costs, y pertinent county fine.
