### Failure to pay tax--penalty--exceptions.

[273.150](#). Every owner of a dog and every person who shall suffer or permit a dog to remain upon such premises under his immediate control without having caused such dog to be listed and the tax thereon to be paid as provided for by sections [273.040](#) to [273.180](#) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof fined not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars; provided, that none of the provisions of sections [273.040](#) to [273.180](#) shall apply to cities which now have or may hereafter have a population of three hundred thousand inhabitants or more.
