7-23-2110. Barking dog control. The governing body of a county may, by adoption of an ordinance that substantially complies with <u>7-5-103</u> through <u>7-5-107</u>, regulate barking dogs. An ordinance adopted pursuant to this section may not apply to a dog that is owned, kept, or harbored as part of the business of a licensed veterinarian, animal boarding facility, or agricultural or livestock operation.
